







WHAT IS iC4C?

The centre hosts international and UK artists alongside the public as participants, makers and commentators, in order to create extraordinary experiences for all.









WHAT SPACES CAN I HIRE?

STUDIO 1


- 13.4m x 9.6m approx
- Sprung floor with black lino
- Lighting grid with basic lanterns & control desk
- Plenty of natural light due to dual aspect windows with black curtain tracking enabling full blackout





STUDIO 2

- 17.8m x 11.3m approx
- Wooden sprung floor
- Natural light from 4-5 windows on 3 sides
- Black out blinds on windows



WHAT DOES STUDIO HIRE INCLUDE?

- Air cooling & heating
- Audio rack and speakers
- 13A sockets
- Data points
- 32A and 63A power supply
- WiFi
- All studios are fitted with hearing induction loop
- One dressing room with 2 showers and a green room.


STUDIO 3


- 11.3m x 11.3m approx
- Sprung floor with grey lino
- Barres and mirrors
- Blackout blinds on 2 windows and skylights


Single space hire or package hires are available.
