BIG BODIES CABARET an innovative dance theatre project that joyfully celebrates body positivity and movement. It challenges societal norms surrounding body image by creating a vibrant space where diverse bodies are not just seen but genuinely celebrated.

Through a dynamic blend of dance, storytelling, and performance, the cabaret explores the unique experiences of plus-size people, emphasising the intersectionality of race, gender, and body size.

The 75-minute show showcases a talented, diverse cast, inviting audiences to engage with themes of empowerment and acceptance. With a post-show rave, it fosters communal joy, emphasising that everybody deserves love and representation on stage and beyond.
